

Privacy policy

Pursuant to Regulation 2016/679/EU (General Data Protection Regulation - hereinafter "GDPR"), TIM S.p.a. (hereinafter "TIM") hereby provides the following information regarding the processing of personal data provided by you by registering and filling in the online form to submit your innovative solution and be part of the TIM WCAP Open Innovation Platform.

1. Purposes for which data processing is necessary and related legal basis

The data provided by you (names of founders, managers and advisors, information on the proposed solution, including pictures and videos) will be processed [*as indicated in the "participation rules" of the Rules and Regulations accepted by you*] in compliance with the applicable data protection laws, for the following purposes:

- registration with the website <https://wcap.tim.it> (TIM WCAP site)
- establishment of a database of all the startups registered with the TIM WCAP site
- evaluation of your innovative solution, also by means of business matching meetings, to be integrated into the TIM value chain
- analysis of your innovative solution also in the context of Corporate Venture Capital initiatives
- *handle any requests and/or complaints.*

Your data may also be processed by TIM to assert or defend its rights in court, and to comply with obligations provided for by laws, regulations or EU legislation, as well as by provisions of any supervisory authorities or other competent institutional bodies.

2. Data Retention

TIM, in compliance with the principles of proportionality and necessity, will keep your personal data for the time necessary for the purpose pursued, without prejudice to any further periods required by law for administrative purposes or to handle any complaints or disputes.

3. Methods and logic of data processing

The data will be processed manually (e.g., on paper) and/or by means of computerised and digital tools (e.g., using electronic devices and support tools), with data organisation and processing logics correlated to the aforementioned purposes and, in any case, so as to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data.

4. Data Controller, Data Protection Officer and other categories authorised to process the data

Data Controller is TIM, with registered offices in via Gaetano Negri, no. 1 - 20123 Milan.

Personal data will be processed by employees of the Strategy-Business Development Department of TIM. The aforementioned employees have been authorised to process personal data and have received adequate operating instructions in this regard.

5. Categories of third parties to whom the data may be communicated in their capacity as Data Controllers or who may become aware of them in their capacity as Data Processors.

In addition to TIM employees, some data processing may be carried out by third parties, including companies belonging to the Telecom Italia Group, which are entrusted by TIM of certain activities (or part of such activities) for the purposes set forth under point 1 above. Such parties will act as independent data controllers or will be designated as data processors and may be included in the following categories: partners in the innovation ecosystem and suppliers of technological infrastructures.

6. Right of access to personal data and other rights

You have the right to access your data at any time and to exercise all other rights provided for under this agreement (e.g., to request the origin of the data, rectification of inaccurate

or incomplete data, restriction of processing, cancellation or oblivion, portability of data, as well as to object to their use for legitimate reasons) by sending an email to info.timwcap@telecomitalia.it. Finally, you have the right to file a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.
